DNR RECREATION PLAN WORK SHOP

The City of Caspian has been working towards creation of a DNR recreation plan. During this process a committee made up of local residents and participants from the surrounding area representing numerous recreational entities have gathered information and input from a wide variety of the area public that look to the City of Caspian for recreational activities.

The City and the Recreation Committee are holding a public work shop for the purpose of reviewing the existing information that has been gathered including the results of the community survey that was recently undertaken. The work shop is further intended to obtain additional input regarding the current outline of the proposed recreation plan for the City of Caspian.

The adoption of a State of Michigan approved Recreation Plan is prerequisite to the City's ability to apply for Michigan DNR Recreation Grants. In prior years the City of Caspian has successfully been awarded such Grants associated with Construction of: The Apple Blossom Trail, The Multi-Purpose Building (Ice Rink) and Leo Remondini Park.
